WORD OF THE WEEK

ALPHA & OMEGA are two Greek words. They are the first and the last letters of the Greek alphabet. Look closely at the Paschal Candle where you can see these letters / signs. Christ uses this language of Himself in *Revelation 22*. In calling Himself the 'Alpha' and 'Omega,' Jesus asserts that He is without beginning and without end; He is eternal.

Rev. Tyler and Yanela McMiller

Serving the Lord in Italy.

The Rev. Tyler and Yanela McMiller serve the Lord through The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod as missionaries in Eurasia, based in Italy. Tyler is the sole LCMS pastor in Italy,



where he provides spiritual care for a number of Italians who discovered Lutheranism online and want to learn more. Tyler also mentors four Italian men who are studying to become pastors through an online Lutheran seminary based in Riga, Latvia, and he provides Word and Sacrament ministry to small groups of Lutherans scattered throughout Greece and Bulgaria.

Tyler was born in Waukesha, Wis., although his family served as missionaries in Central and South America during much of his childhood. He received a bachelor's degree in history and Spanish from Concordia University Wisconsin, Mequon, Wis., and a Master of Divinity degree from Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, Ind. Prior to attending the seminary, Tyler was a violinist in a Mariachi band (2010–2014) and a GEO missionary to Mexico and the Dominican Republic (2014–2017), where he met his wife. Yanela was born in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic. Yanela received an education degree from Universidad Dominicana O&M in Santo Domingo. After graduating, she was the director of the Lutheran Preschool in Licey, Dominican Republic, and served as the mission secretary for the local Lutheran mission.

Please pray for the McMillers as they serve in Italy. Pray for their health and safety as they travel around the region to connect with small groups of believers. Pray also that the Holy Spirit would continue to uplift these believers even as they deal with the loneliness and isolation of their situation. Let us give thanks to God for Tyler and Yanela's service to God's children in this part of the world.


